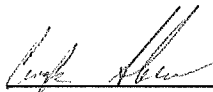

- No citizens were present for Board meeting discussions.

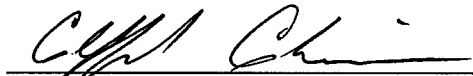
Adjournment
